

The exercises are played without participation of the right hand.

Through emphasizing the beat, both upwards and downwards legato are practiced.

Make sure that you don't practice too fast!!!
Relax the fingers that are not in use for the moment and use only that speed that allow you to produce the tones evenly, both dynamically and rhythmically.

With exception for the exercises n:o 6 and 7, these exercises are not any tonality trainings for the ear. They are mainly for strengthening the left hand and learning to govern your fingers to use exactly the right force combined with relaxation. So don't overdo it! Just use it as a warming up, together with the right hand exercises...






